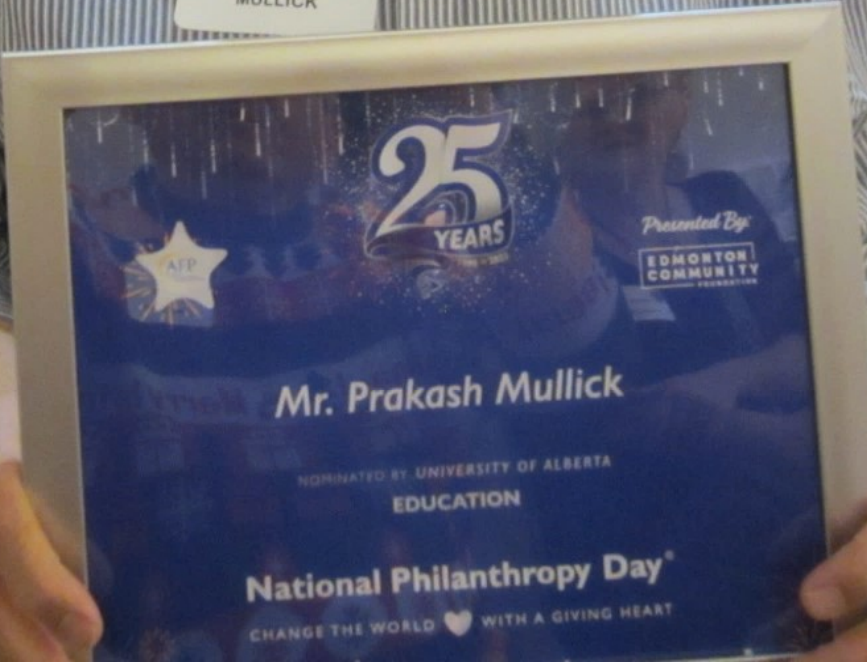

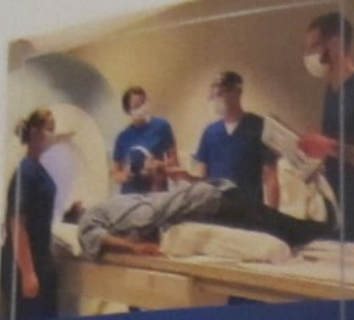

Prakash considers education as the best equalizer and that giving back is the best way to express his sincerest thanks to Canada and to honor his parents.

My journey started with generosity made many years ago, now I can pay it forward to keep the momentum going.
